



## ACO Directory of ADHD Coaches – Listing Requirements

**Standard Listing:** Any member in good standing who attests that they are 1) a trained coach with professional experience working with ADHD clients and 2) have had ADHD-specific training or education may apply to be listed in the ACO Directory of ADHD Coaches with no additional fee.

**Professional ADHD Coach Listing:** Because the ACO values education and excellence in ADHD coaching, we have established criteria to be listed as a “Professional ADHD Coach” in the ACO Directory of ADHD Coaches. To be listed with this label, which will appear under the member’s name, member coaches must demonstrate they have had coaching-specific training (60 hours) as well as ADHD-specific coach training (25-35 hours, depending on the path selected). Please see detailed requirements in the Professional ADHD Coach Listing Requirements table. There is a **\$50 fee** to apply to cover the cost of staff review of the member’s credentials. Members who have been previously had their credentials reviewed and who have been listed in the Directory do not need to reapply, but they do need to update their profile to be complete based on the new “completeness” requirements below.

**Completed Profile Requirement:** To be listed in the ACO Directory of ADHD Coaches, a member profile must have the following attributes completed:

1. Photo (a professional-looking headshot is strongly preferred)
2. Full name
3. Location (City, State, Country)
4. At least one of the following contact methods:
  - Email (Directory Email)
  - Website
  - Phone (Directory Phone)
5. Specialties (at least one selected)
6. Coaching Formats ((at least one selected)
7. Member Bio
8. Education, Training & Certifications

Please note that a member phone number or email address will only appear in the Directory if the member populates the “Directory Phone” and “Directory Email” profile attributes.
